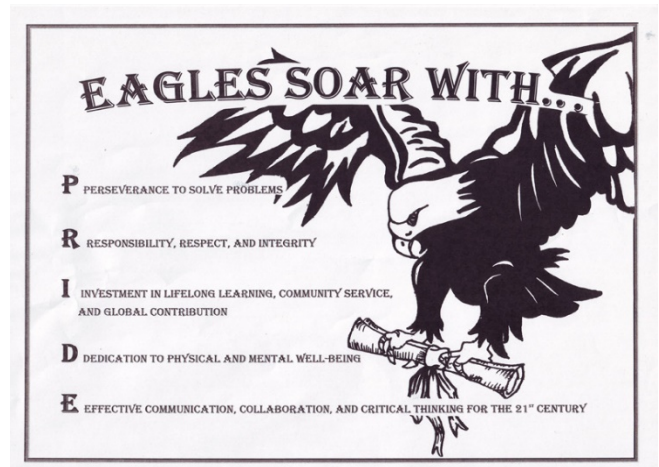

ARS §11-269.12 **food handler** means any person **who** handles, prepares, serves, sells or gives away **food** for consumption by persons other than his or her immediate family, or **who** handles utensils and equipment (<https://www.maricopa.gov/2253/food-employees>)

**Steps to get a Food Employee Certificate (Formerly Food Handler's Card)**

- A valid card or certificate issued by an ANSI-accredited food handler training program. A list of the ANSI-accredited programs can be found on

**FYI ...Certified Food Protection Manager (kitchen manager) has the management responsibility and the authority to direct and control food preparation and service. 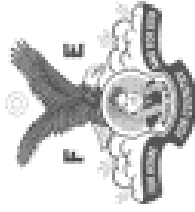
