I've been in Flexible, but only when it was very important to stand firm.

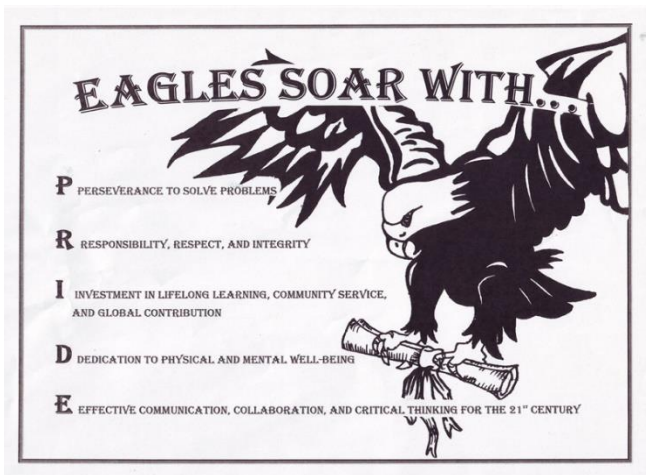
Sometimes I'm in Capable, and I go there more often as I'm getting older.

Who needs a Food Employee Certificate (formerly Food Handler’s Card)

ARS §11-269.12 **food handler** means any person **who** handles, prepares, serves, sells or gives away **food** for consumption by persons other than his or her immediate family, or **who** handles utensils and equipment

Steps to get a Food Employee Certificate (Formerly Food Handler's Card)

- A valid card or certificate issued by an ANSI-accredited food handler training program. A list of the ANSI-accredited programs can be found on <https://www.ansi.org/accreditation/credentialing/certificate.../food-handler-certificates/>

FYI ...Certified Food Protection Manager (kitchen manager) has the management responsibility and the authority to direct and control food preparation and service. Please note all certificates need to be handed in Kindly drop in the Aerie Secretary’s Door. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

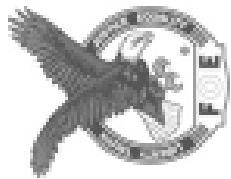

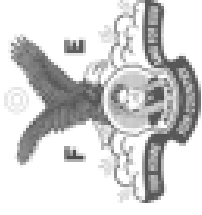
